Dear Fremd High School Orchestra Parents, Guardians, and Student\_\_\_\_\_.

Today your student received his tuxedo jacket and cummerbund for upcoming concert performances. This jacket was selected for him during a fitting based on the best fit possible, and we ask that your jacket not be altered in any way.

**To complete the dress attire for our 2008-2009 Orchestra Concerts,  
each student is asked to please supply the below items:**

- \*White wing-tip collar tuxedo shirt** (*which can be found at such stores as Michaels, Hobby Lobby, Penney's catalog, as well as a tuxedo shop*)
- \*Black bow tie** (*usually included with the purchase of a tux shirt*)
- \*Black dress pants**
- \*Black socks**
- \*Black dress shoes**

All these items will be needed for the Orchestra Concert on Tuesday, December 9.

Please note that the tuxedo jacket and cummerbund which the Music Department is supplying to you will need to be returned to school in the spring after the final orchestra concert. Advance notice for this will be given. The cummerbund is attached to the hanger.

*Throughout the school year we recommend that the tuxedo jacket and cummerbund be cleaned at a reputable dry cleaner when necessary. In the spring we will ask for you to please dry clean the tuxedo jacket and cummerbund once more, leaving the dry cleaning receipt, along with your student's name, on the plastic bag when it is returned to ease the end-of-the-year check-in process.*
