

Fremd Vocal/Piano/Guitar Conservatory

Policy Guidelines

Voice, piano, and guitar lessons are provided at Fremd High School by highly qualified private instructors. All have degrees in music and have had extensive experience teaching and performing. Lessons include basic vocal and playing technique as well as repertoire study in both classical and popular genres. Students are helped to choose literature and prepare for such events as IMEA Auditions, Vocal Chamber Night in March, Let the Stars Come Out (a vocal musical theater revue) in April, and various studio recitals. New Choral Assistant Mrs. Spurling will be offering Piano Lessons!

Lessons are available during the student's free periods (including lunch) or after school. On occasion, an instructor is available in the evening. (Students may REQUEST their instructor but may not always receive their first choice.) These weekly lessons are scheduled first come, first served and follow the Fremd High School semester calendar. Lessons will be scheduled until each instructor's time slots are full. It is in your best interest to return the contract as soon as possible.

The fee for a 28 minute lesson is \$20.00 per lesson. The student is expected to complete an entire semester of lessons and is responsible for that payment. **PAYMENT IS DUE BEFORE THE LESSONS OCCUR.** Payments can be made at the beginning of the semester or at the beginning of each month. Lessons may need to be rescheduled due to irregular school day schedules, teacher absences, etc. Lessons missed by the student will be made up at the instructor's discretion.

A small number of scholarships are available from the Fremd Music Association each semester. Students need to be enrolled in a free or reduced lunch program at Fremd and receive Mr. Green's endorsement. A parent needs to submit a letter with the contract to Mr. Green stating they are on the free or reduced lunch program.

Students are expected to attend lessons and practice EVERY WEEK. The only way to progress is to be diligent and work hard. Positive results will be seen with a determined outlook and a consistent work ethic.
