Please note:

Volunteering involves being a dog handler or assisting with cat adoptions (cats only at Bloomingdale store) on Saturdays for four hours. If you don't have five Saturdays and four hours each Saturday to volunteer, then choose another organization.

Dog handling is NOT for everyone. If it is more challenging than you had imagined, the responsible and mature action would be to seek a different organization better suited to your interests and experience.

A good command of English is mandatory.

An email account and internet access is required to volunteer.

Volunteers are expected to maintain a minimum contact by **email several times a week.**

Reliable transportation is necessary as you may be required to volunteer at adoption shows in locations other than Schaumburg. (Bloomingdale)

Students must sign in and sign out with the site supervisor on the provided form at each adoption site.

Students are expected to wear their name badges and bring their time cards.

Your commitment:

I understand my primary responsibility is to keep animals and humans safe at all times.

I understand that to receive course credit I must meet the requirements of my high school and the Almost Home Foundation organization.

I understand that I must maintain regular email contact with the AHF Student Volunteer Coordinator.

I understand that I am committing to a minimum of five Saturdays of volunteer service.

I understand I am expected to have reliable transportation and that it may be necessary to travel to any one of the three PetSmart stores (2 in Schaumburg; 1 in Bloomingdale).

I understand that I am responsible for maintaining a record of my hours of service; that I must sign in and sign out at each adoption show and that I should have the adoption site supervisor initial my school's time card each time I volunteer.

I understand I am expected to wear a name tag that identifies me as a volunteer from District #211.
