Dear Graduating Senior;

Each year the Viking Booster Club awards scholarships to outstanding members of the senior class. These recipients will be chosen on the basis of their accomplishments in the areas of **1) Leadership, 2) School Activities, 3) Service and 4) All Around** (includes Leadership, School Activities and Service). In addition, scholarship opportunities are available to seniors who plan on attending a **5) Community College and/or Trade School**. Financial need and academic accomplishments are NOT a consideration for any of these scholarships.

The Viking Booster Club will be awarding a minimum of thirty scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each for the 2012 graduating seniors. Each scholarship is awarded independently. Students may apply for only two scholarship categories; however, a student may only be awarded one scholarship over all.

We encourage *ALL* seniors that are planning on furthering their education at four year colleges and universities as well as community colleges and trade schools to apply.

4. Follow the instructions on each form for each category.
5. Please type your responses. If a typed response is not an option, please write legibly and neatly.
6. Please number pages 1/1, or if more than one page is needed, 1/2, etc.
7. Do not staple the application.
8. Six (6) copies of your application(s) should be submitted. Please paperclip each copy separately. Each copy should include one Personal/Future Statement Page and the category specific page(s)
9. Do not include any additional material, photos or awards with your application.

Please return one original of this Information Page, plus six (6) copies of the application (Step 8), in a sealed envelope marked Booster Scholarship Application to the collection box in Fremd Student Services Office by 3:00 pm on March 23, 2012 (Friday before Spring Break).

Students who are awarded scholarships will be notified by regular mail.
