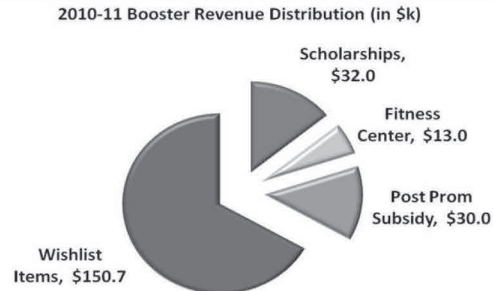

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

32 Fremd Seniors received a \$1,000 scholarship in May. Students were selected for their outstanding efforts in Leadership, Community Service, Fremd Service, and Fremd Activities. Scholarships were also awarded to students planning to attend a Junior College or Trade School.

SPORTS PROGRAMS

Boosters publish three sports programs for the fall, winter, and spring athletic seasons. Student Clubs sell the sports programs to raise money for their activities.

SPORTS RECOGNITION NIGHTS
