This year's program will be held at Conant High School located at 700 East Cougar Trail, Hoffman Estates, IL. The event will take place on Wednesday, October 19 from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m.


Students and parents will be able to speak with Admissions representatives and ask questions regarding campus and curriculum offerings. Large Midwestern universities will each sponsor 30-minute group presentations in classrooms. Additionally, Jackie Slaats, the Athletic Director and Senior Assistant to the President at Lake Forest College, will present information on NCAA Division I, II & III eligibility requirements and Tony Bankston, Dean of Admissions from Illinois Wesleyan University, will speak on the topic of admission to highly selective universities. High school counselors will be available to answer questions about financial aid, scholarships and application information.

In past years, we have attracted very large crowds to this program. To alleviate parking and traffic problems, we are providing shuttle-bus transportation from each high school to the College Night Program. Buses will leave from Fremd High school at 6:15 p.m. and run continuously until 6:45 p.m. The shuttle service will return participants to Fremd High school beginning at 7:30 p.m. and continuing until 8:30 p.m. We strongly encourage you to take the shuttle for a hassle-free evening.

There is no fee for shuttle bus service, but riders are asked to sign-up in the College and Career Center at Fremd High school by October 14. You may telephone the office at 847-755-2630 to register.
